WHO ARE WE

are the Voice of the University of Miami, a 1,300 Kilowatt radio station broadcasting from the Coral Gables Campus. We have been completely student run since 1968. Yes, we are a real radio station. Yes, you can work for us if you qualify. We are located at 90.5FM on the FM dial and streaming is available online at wvum.org. You can also listen on your smartphone! We play alternative music (indie alternative & electronic) and have various specialty shows of other genres: world, reggae, disco, punk, funk, hip-hop, indie specialty, a blog show, underground house, and local bands. Our sports team covers Hurricane athletics on air. Our news team updates the Miami community about current events in the Miami and national communities. We have an executive board of 14 members who oversee most operations.

HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?

1. You must be a full-time student at UM and be in good academic standing.
2. Do your homework: Have you listened to us before? Do you know the positions that are offered?
3. APPLY to work with us: fill out our application (also available online) and submit it to our office (located at the back entrance of the UC)

POSITIONS

WVUM DJ: Host your own 2-hour rotation show on 90.5FM with music most often played on WVUM. After a semester, you may apply to host a specialty show of a specific genre. You will need to be trained and pass an FCC test before going on air. Experience is not necessary. Dustin: training@wvum.org

SPORTS STAFF: Broadcasting volleyball, football and baseball. Get involved if you bleed orange and green. You can also become a part of weekly sports talk shows. Chris: sports@wvum.org

NEWS STAFF: Become an on-air newscaster or write news articles for our website. Savanna: news@wvum.org

PROMOTIONS STAFF: Hit the streets and tell everyone about WVUM. Plan events on and off campus and network like crazy. Uchi and Danielle: pr@wvum.org
